

'DUAL-WAY.EXE'

Known Imperfection of the Program.

During making a pair of content catalogs in \SDW and \ZIP (when you run the batch files made by '2Batch.EXE'), the alphabetical listing switch '/on' doesn't function perfectly in some folder names, and some filenames, which have the exact same name at front then have the minor difference after Dot(.) in extension.

**dir /s /on =**

**dir** (make **dir**ectory catalog) **/s** (include all **s**ubdirectories)  
**/on** (and **s**ort them alphabetically by **n**ames).

This command is used for making a pair of catalogs. And the last command switch ('/on') sometimes juggle up between the pair. For example,

A catalog file at \SDW\ looks like,

```
LTR-MAIL.OUT <DIR>  
LTR-MAIL.IN <DIR>
```

while a catalog file at \ZIP\ looks like,

```
LTR-MAIL.IN <DIR>  
LTR-MAIL.OUT <DIR>
```

Strictly speaking, a catalog file in \SDW is making a mistake, because 'IN' should be upper than 'OUT' by alphabetical order. This minor sorting order mishaps appear in the final \DIFF report. But once you become familiar about this, you can easily recognize these sorting juggles in the final report as artifacts, and you can ignore. Please double check by yourself the pair of catalog files of directories in \SDW and \ZIP, then you will be convinced.

Addition or deletion of a file, change in byte size of an existing file, a name change of a folder, all of these should appear as Big Change Report in the final reports in \DIFF. If you know a way to fix this known imperfection to the perfection, let us know (please write to TuneFind). Thank you!
